The Problem

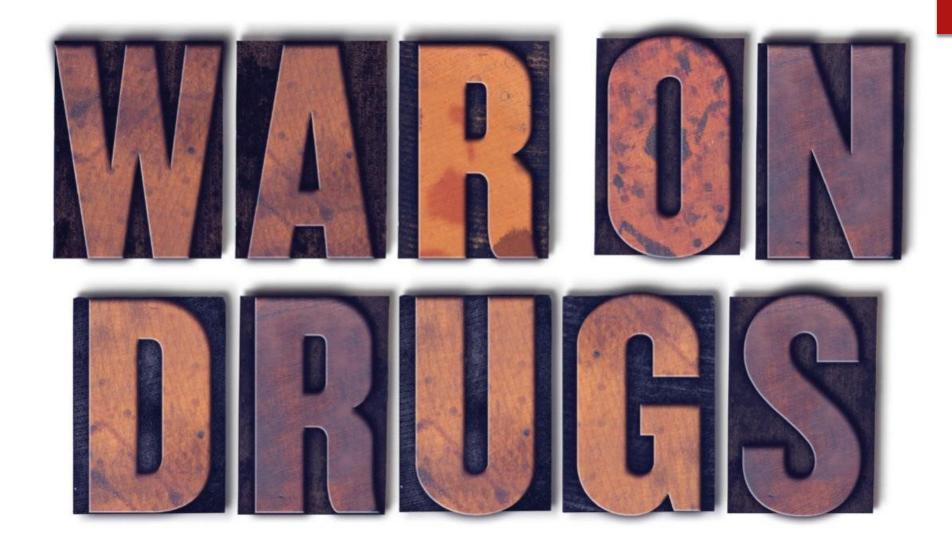
MOST PEOPLE WITH ADDICTIONS DO NOT ACCESS SERVICES



More Problems

Culturally, Americans do not know what to do in response to addictions at all levels – including the community and family level.







The logic of the war on drugs is that people with addictions are dangerous criminals who are prone to violence against innocent people.

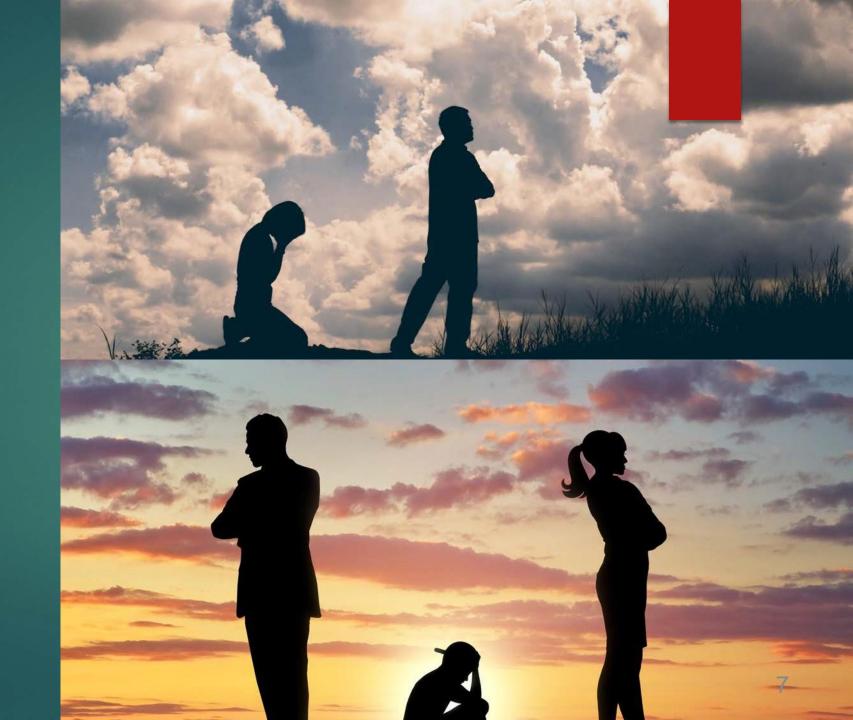
If this is true, then we should punish, shame, and lock-up people so bad that no one will use drugs because they are too afraid.5



Either you cut off all contact or you are enabling.

The Truth is that Most People with addictions are traumatized, depressed, anxious and desperate to get control over their lives. Addiction cuts people from their dreams, goals, families and eventually even themselves.

The logic of the drug war has taken over our society, even our families. This makes families want to punish and hurt their already hurting addicted loved ones.



The Answer

- Help families connect in positive ways that provide boundaries.
- Strengthen bonds and use them to guide behaviors.



The Answer

- Community Reinforcement and Family Training (CRAFT)
- Developed by Robert J. Meyers PhD at UNM.
- CRAFT is the ONLY Evidence Based
 Practice designed for families of persons with addiction.
- CRAFT research shows that family members can positively motivate people who struggle with addictions to voluntarily enter treatment 7 out of 10 times.
- It is also showed proof that families can make it more likely that people stay in treatment and move towards long-term recovery.

What is CRAFT?

CRA =

Community Reinforcement Approach

CRA is an approach for treating substance abuse, that aims to help the substance abuser change their lives (environment, community etc.) so that sobriety becomes more rewarding (reinforcing) than using.

CRA + FT=Family Training

What is CRAFT?

CRAFT is to train family members how to utilize CRA in their own homes.

The Basics of CRAFT

- Elimination of positive reinforcement for drinking and/or using behavior
- Enhancement of positive reinforcement for non-drinking (sober) and non-using behavior

CRAFT'S 3 MAJOR GOALS

- The happiness scale is a tool that we use to have a client led assessment.
- It helps with assess client's happiness and satisfaction. We then use this to determine goals.

Why focus on family members?

- Individuals who engage in treatment often report that family encouraged them to seek treatment
- Families can influence substance abusers' behavior due to extensive contact
- Families are the true experts on an abuser's behavior
- Families also need help (victims of violence, verbal assaults, \$ problems, marital conflict, etc.)

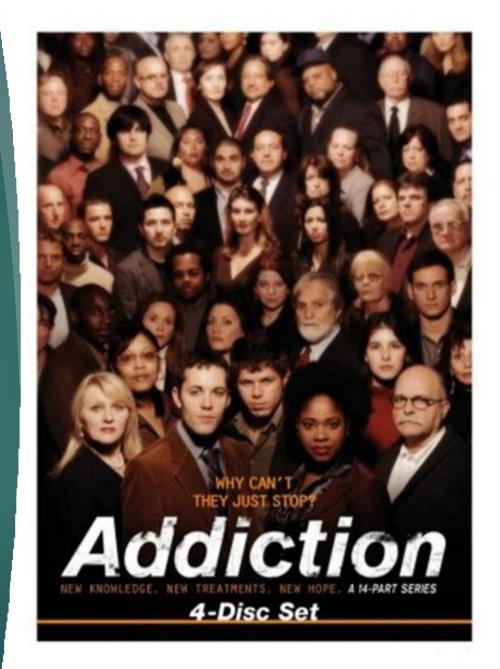

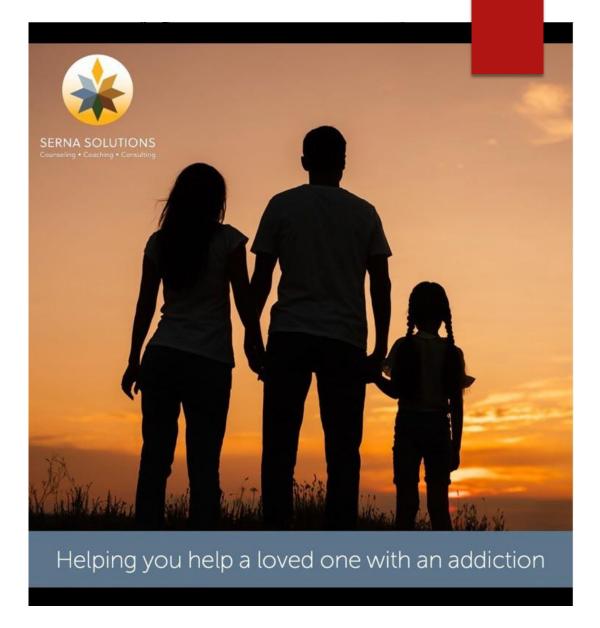
